JUDGMENT

This Suit has been filed by the plaintiff under order VII, Rule 1 of CPC to direct the defendant to pay a sum of Rs.45,75,000/-(Rupees forty five lakh and seventy five thousand only) together with interest at the rate of 18% per annum from the date of plaint till the date of realization in full and for costs.

Plaintiffs called and found absent. The learned counsel for plaintiffs is not ready to commence the trial. Issues are framed as early as on 30.06.2025 itself. The plaintiff did not show any interest in prosecuting this suit for the past one year. Already more than sufficient opportunities were given. Nothing is availed of. Hence, the suit is dismissed for default.
