

BA 641 Mukul Roy & another Vs. State

Today the case was fixed for arguments on bail application filed by the accused persons Lipika and Mukul Roy. Arguments heard. Case file perused.

From the perusal of the case file and arguments advanced, it transpires that :-

- (1) The present case relates to offences under Section 323, 406, 498 A and 506 of IPC.
- (2) The accused persons were granted bail vide orders dated 19.09.2023 and 25.10.2024. However, the accused persons failed to appear on 03.12.2025 and their bail was accordingly cancelled. They were produced before the Court by their surety Nupur Pal on 10.12.2025 and have since then been in custody.
- (3) In the present case examination of only one witness is remaining.
- (4) The accused persons have been in custody since long. Investigation in the present case is complete. No further recovery is to made. Their further detention will serve no fruitful purpose. Offences as alleged against the accused persons are punishable with imprisonment up to three years.

In light of the above discussions, **the bail application of above named accused persons is hereby allowed subject to furnishing bail bond in the sum of Rs.30,000/- each with one surety of like amount. Bail bonds and surety bonds not furnished.** Bail application stand disposed of. Papers be tagged with the main file.
