This petition is coming on this day before this court for hearing in the presence of M/s.P.Thinesh, G.D.Pon Prabhakaran, the Counsel for the petitioners and of the CPP for respondent police and upon hearing both sides, this Court delivered the following,

ORDER

1. The petitioners, who were arrested on 19.05.2026 for the offences punishable under Section 296(b), 115(2), 118(1), 351(3) of BNS r/w sec. 4 of TNPHW Act in Crime No.133/2026 on the file of the respondent police, seeks bail.

2. The Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners are innocent and they have not committed any offence as alleged, they have been falsely implicated in this case by the police. The petitioners are in custody from 19.05.2026. Hence, prays for granting bail.

3. On the other hand, learned CPP submits that due to wordy quarrel, the petitioners went to the defacto complainant's house, abused the defacto complainant and her son in filthy language, and physically assaulted them with a wooden log stone and caused injuries to them. The victims were treated as outpatient and later got discharged. The petitioners 1 and 2 are having 2 and 4 previous cases respectively. However, if they are let on bail, possibility of abscond and indulge in similar kind of offence. Hence, he strongly opposed the petition.

4. The petitioners are in custody from 19.05.2026. Considering the nature of allegations made against the petitioners, previous bad antecedents and the strong objection raised by the CPP, this court is not inclined to grant bail at present.

5. Hence, the petition is dismissed.
