This petition is coming on this day before this court for hearing in the presence of M/s. S. Abimanyu, Sai Pragadeesh, the Counsel for the petitioner and of the CPP for respondent police and upon hearing both sides, this Court delivered the following,

ORDER

1. The petitioner seeks relaxation of the condition imposed by this court in Crl.M.P.No.3536/2026, dt: 18.04.2026.

2. The petitioner was granted anticipatory bail by this court in Crl.M.P.No.1560/2026, dt: 02.03.2026 for the offence under Section 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 r/w 34 of IPC on condition to appear before the respondent police daily at 10.00 a.m. until further orders. The above condition was modified and the petitioner was directed to appear before the respondent police once in a week, on every Monday at 10.00 a.m. until further orders.

3. Learned CPP submits that the petitioner has complied the condition for 6 times.

4. Considering the nature of case and the number of days complied, this court is inclined to modify the condition as follows:

"The petitioner is directed to appear before the respondent police once in 15 days at 10.00 a.m. for 3 months".
