This petition is coming on this day before this court for hearing in the presence of M/s.S.Magesh Kumar, R.Udaya Kumar and M.Kadhirvel, the Counsel for the petitioner and of the CPP for respondent police and upon hearing both sides, this Court delivered the following,

ORDER

1. The petitioner, who apprehends arrest by the respondent police for the alleged offences punishable u/s 296(b), 115(2), 191(2), 191(3) and 351(3) of BNS in Crime No.96/2026 on the file of the respondent police, seeks anticipatory bail.

2. The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is innocent and he has not committed any offence as alleged. The petitioner apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent police. Hence, prays for anticipatory bail.

3. On the other hand, the learned CPP submits that due to quarrel in the election day, the petitioner and others assaulted the defacto complainant with hands and knife and threatened him. The injured was admitted in the hospital for two days and thereafter, discharged. Arrest of the petitioner is necessary for interrogation. Hence, he strongly opposed the petition.

4. It is brought to the notice of this court that totally 10 accused and the petitioner is A1 / main accused. As per the allegation, the petitioner and others joined together and assaulted the victim with hands and knife. The injured suffered injuries on his face and head. He has taken treatment for two days. Considering the nature of

allegation made against the petitioner and the injuries sustained by the victim, this court is not inclined to grant anticipatory bail.

5. Petition is dismissed.
