This petition is coming on this day before this court for hearing in the presence of M/s. Sasikumar, the Counsel for the petitioner and of the Special Public Prosecutor for respondent police and upon hearing both sides, this Court delivered the following,

ORDER

1. The petitioner seeks relaxation of the condition imposed by this court in Crl.M.P.No.3208/2026, dt: 09.04.2026.

2. The petitioner was granted bail by this court in Crl.M.P.No.2109/2026, dt: 06.03.2026 for the offence under Section 69 of BNS altered to Sec 69 and u/s Sec.3(2)(v) of the Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act on condition to appear before the respondent police daily at 10.00 a.m. until further orders. The above condition was modified and the petitioner was directed to appear before the respondent police once in a week, on every Monday at 10.00 a.m. until further orders.

3. Learned SPP submitted that the petitioner has complied the condition for 8 times.

4. Considering the nature of case and the number of days complied, this court is inclined to modify the condition as follows:

"The petitioner is directed to appear before the respondent police once in a Month, i.e. First working day of English Calendar Month at 10.00 a.m. until further orders".
