This petition is coming on this day before this court for hearing in the presence of M/s.R.Deepak, P.Devi Sai Monica and A.K.Bhavani Devi, the Counsel for the petitioner and of the CPP for respondent police and upon hearing both sides, this Court delivered the following,

ORDER

1. The petitioner, who was arrested on 21.05.2026 for the offences punishable under Section 140(4), 143(1)(d), 143(2), 316(2) and 318(2) of BNS and u/s 10 and 24 of the Emigration Act, 1983 and u/s 66D of the Information Technology Act, 2000 in Crime No.57/2026 on the file of the respondent police, seeks bail.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is innocent and he has not committed any offence as alleged. The petitioner is in custody from 21.05.2026. Hence, prays for bail.

3. On the other hand, the learned CPP submits that it is a case of human-trafficking. The petitioner and others promised to arrange job at Cambodia and received a sum of Rs.50,000/- from the defacto complainant and sent him to Cambodia. When the defacto complainant went to Cambodia, he was asked to do online scam work. On coming to know that he was cheated by the accused, the defacto complainant, with the help of Indian Embassy officials, returned to India. He further submitted that the other accused are yet to be arrested. The petitioner

was arrested only on 14.05.2026 and investigation is in the initial stage. Hence, he strongly opposed the petition.

4. Considering the gravity of offence alleged to have been committed by the accused and the initial stage of the investigation, this court is not inclined to grant bail.

5. Petition is dismissed.
