This petition is coming on this day before this court for hearing in the presence of M/s. G. Vasudevan, M. Prakash, S. Kalaikumar, the counsel for the petitioner and of the CPP for the respondent and upon hearing them, this Court delivered the following

ORDER

1. The petitioner, who was arrested on 15.05.2026 for the offences punishable under Section 296(b), 115(2), 118(1), 125, 351(3) of BNS r/w. Sec.4 of TNPHW Act in Crime No.287/2026 on the file of the respondent police, seeks bail.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is innocent. He has not committed any offence. He has been falsely implicated in this case. It is a case and counter case. A3 was granted bail by the court below. The petitioner is in custody from 15.05.2026. Hence, prays for granting bail.

3. On the other hand, learned CPP submits that due to dispute relating to an Instagram message, the petitioner and others picked quarrel with the defacto complainant's husband and assaulted him. When the defacto complainant, who is a pregnant lady, intervened, the accused pushed her down and caused injuries and also attacked the relatives of the defacto complainant, who came to their rescue, with wooden log. The victims were treated as out-patient. Investigation is pending.

He further submits that the petitioner is having previous cases and he has been detained under Act 14 of 1982 vide order No.249, dated 08.06.2026.

4. Considering the nature of offence, the fact that the petitioner has been in custody under preventive detention order, this court is not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner at this stage.

5. Hence, the petition is dismissed.
