This petition is coming on this day before this court for hearing in the presence of M/s. A. Esakipandy, S. Ramesh Kumar, V. Suryaprakash, R. Balaji, the Counsel for the petitioner and of the CPP for the respondent and upon hearing them, this Court delivered the following

**ORDER**

1. The petitioner, who was arrested on 08.05.2026 for the offence punishable u/s. 191(2), 191(3), 296(b), 115(2), 118(1), 109(1), 351(3) of BNS in Crime No.31/2026 on the file of the respondent police, seek bail.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is innocent. Originally, the petitioner was arrested in another crime number and in this case, he was arrested formally. He has not committed any offence as alleged by the prosecution. He has been falsely implicated in this case. Co-accused were already enlarged on bail by this court. The petitioner is in custody from 08.05.2026. Hence, prays for granting bail.

3. On the other hand, learned CPP submits that due to previous enmity, this petitioner/A1 along with 4 other accused attacked the defacto complainant with wooden log, beer bottle and caused injuries on the head, face and his back side. The injured has been treated as in-patient for 3 days and got discharged. Investigation is pending. The petitioner is having 20 previous cases. He further submits that the alleged occurrence took place in the month of February 2026,

however, he managed to escape. Only on 30.04.2026, he was arrested in connection with another Cr.No.141/2026 on the file of Vyasarpadi Police Station and in this case he was formally arrested on 07.05.2026. Investigation is pending. He cannot claim parity with that of the co-accused. If he is enlarged on bail, he will again indulge in similar offence. Hence, he objects granting bail.

4. Considering the nature of offence, the bad antecedents of the petitioner and the objection raised by learned CPP, this court is not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

5. Petition is dismissed.
