ORDER

1. Petitioner seeks extension of time granted in Crl.M.P.No.1/2025 in C.A.No.931/2025 dated 21.04.2026.

2. As per the order passed in Crl.M.P.No.1/2025 in C.A.No.931/2025 dated 21.04.2026, this court has suspended the sentence imposed by the trial court and directed the petitioner to deposit a sum of Rs.7,00,000/- (Rupees Seven Lakhs Only) before the trial court to the credit of C.C. within 8 weeks.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is a senior citizen and having various ailments and unable to mobilize the funds within the time. Hence, prays for extension of time.

4. Considering the reason stated by the petitioner, this court is inclined to extend the time for four weeks.

5. (i) Petition is allowed.

(ii) Four weeks time till 13.07.2026 is granted to comply with order passed in Crl.M.P.No.1/2025 in C.A.No.931/2025.
