This petition is coming on this day before this court for hearing in the presence of M/s.M. Thiagarajan, E. Ganesh and M. Devi, the counsel for the petitioner, upon hearing the counsel for the petitioner, this Court delivered the following,

ORDER

1. The petitioner seeks suspension of sentence pending disposal of the appeal.

2. The Petitioner/Appellant herein is the accused in C.C.No.5937/2019 on the file of the learned VI Metropolitan Magistrate, Egmore, Chennai. On 08.07.2025, judgment was pronounced in the above case and the petitioner was convicted u/s 279, 304 A IPC and 134 (a,b) r/w 187 MV Act, 37 cl (i) TNMV Rule r/w 177 of MV Act and for the offence u/s 279 of IPC, he was sentenced to pay a fine of Rs.1,000/- and for the offence u/s 304A of IPC, he was sentenced

to undergo one year simple imprisonment and to pay a fine of Rs.1,000/-, and for the offence u/s 134 (a,b) r/w 187 MV Act, he was sentenced to pay a fine of Rs.500/- and for the offence u/s 37 cl (i) TNMV Rule r/w 177 of MV Act, he was sentenced to pay a fine of Rs.100/- and in total a sum of Rs.2,600/- was imposed on the petitioner.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that the petitioner has fair chance of success in the appeal. Hence, prays for suspension of sentence.

4. The trial court has suspended the sentence. Fine amount has been paid. The appellant has made out arguable case. Hence, this court is inclined to suspend the sentence imposed by the trial court pending appeal.

5. Accordingly, the substantial sentence of imprisonment imposed on the petitioner by the trial Court alone is hereby suspended till the disposal of the appeal and the petitioner is ordered to be enlarged on bail on his executing a bond for Rs.10,000/- with two sureties each for a likesum to the satisfaction of the learned VI Metropolitan Magistrate, Egmore, Chennai within 15 days.
