Both parties are present. On, negotiation, both parties have agreed to the settlement of the dispute for a sum of **RS. 17,50,400/- (Seventeen Lakh Fifty thousand Four hundred Only)**.

The Respondent is/are directed to deposit the settled amount before the competent court within six weeks from the date of this award, failing which the respondent's agreed to pay interest 7.5% per annum on the award amount from today till the date of deposit

The dispute between the parties is settled accordingly. Therefore, the award is passed in accordance with the Sections 21/22 E of Legal Services Authorities Act 1987.

As and when the award amount is deposited in the court, the same shall be disbursed to the petitioner's through NEFT/RTGS. per the directions of the High Court of Madras, in CMA No 428/2016 in the bank account of the petitioner's as given below
