ORDER

(Delivered on 28th day of May of the year 2026)

This Order shall dispose of an application filed by the accused seeking permission to travel abroad under section 205 Cr.PC. (228 of BNSS) for permanent exemption of the accused.

2. It is stated by the accused that he has been recently employed by Costa Fascinosa as F & B Attendant C, through Carnival Support Services India Pvt. Ltd. (Agency) and his first contract will commence from 31.05.2026 and expires on 26.01.2017 and the same is likely to extend yearly. Due to his employment he will be leaving for Italy on 29.05.2026 at 7.10 p.m. If he did not join his employment, then he will lose the job as well as his career will be hampered and it will be very difficult for him to search a new job.

3. It is further stated that the accused is starting his career and looking out for a good job opportunities and this being best option to start, the accused wishes to join the same. As he has to travel abroad for the job it will be difficult for him to appear personally hence, seeks to grant permanent exemption for the hearings and will be represented by his lawyer.

4. Considering the fact that the accused is required to join his duties, discretion under Section 228 of BNSS can be exercised with appropriate condition so as to not hamper trial and will also care of the apprehension shown by the prosecution in its reply.

5. Hence, I pass the following:-

ORDER

Application is granted.

Accused is exempted from personal hearing until further orders from this Court on the following conditions:-

- (i) Accused shall furnish full photograph for the purpose of identification.

(ii) Accused shall furnish detail address and contact information including email id of his employer.

(iii) Accused to furnish his detail address and contact information including email id. Any change in address, contact details and employment to be informed to the Court.

(iv) Accused to remain present before this Court as and when directed by the Court.

(v) Accused no.1 shall always be represented through an Advocate on his behalf.

(vi) Statements made by the Advocate for the accused shall be deemed to be made by the consent of the accused

(vii) Accused shall have no objection in taking evidence in his absence.

(viii) Accused to report to Court on his arrival to India
