Sk. Safidul & another - versus- The State

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Order no. 03 dated 04.08.2026:

The application for anticipatory bail under Section 482 B.N.S.S. filed on behalf of the accused petitioners namely (1) Sk. Safidul, and (2) Sundari Begum @ Jinnatara Begam who apprehend arrest in connection with Raina P.S. Case No. 246 of 2026 dated 25.06.2026 U/Ss 126(2)/115(2)/117(2)/109(1)/352/351(3)/3(5) of B.N.S. is taken up for hearing.

Record of G.R. Case received. C.D. is also produced.

Heard the Ld. Advocate for the petitioners, and Ld. P.P. In-charge.

It is submitted by the Ld. Advocate for the petitioners that these petitioners have been falsely implicated out of grudge. Principal accused who allegedly kicked on the abdomen of a woman carrying child has already been granted bail by this court. No specific role is attributed to these petitioners. It is the further submission of the Ld. Advocate that no such application of these petitioners has either been moved before or rejected by the Hon'ble Court or by this Court on any earlier occasion. Hence, Ld. Advocate prays for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners on any condition as this Court deems fit.

Ld. P.P. In-charge raises no objection.

Perused the materials on record and in the C.D.

It is alleged that the accused persons including these petitioners abused the complainant with filthy language. On protest they assaulted her physically and accused Sk. Liton kicked on her abdomen knowing that she was pregnant.

On perusal of the C.D. it appears that the I.O. has collected the medical documents. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and nature of allegation against these petitioners, their prayer u/s 482 B.N.S.S. is allowed.

In the event of arrest of the above named accused petitioners in connection with the above noted case, they shall be released on bail on furnishing bonds of Rs. 3,000/- each with two sureties of Rs. 1,500/- each, subject to the satisfaction of the arresting officer, on the conditions stipulated in section 482(2) of B.N.S.S. with further direction that the petitioner No.1 Sk. Safidul shall meet with the I.O. of the case once in a week till conclusion of investigation by the I.O.

Let a copy of this order along with the record of G.R. Case be transmitted to the concerned Court for information and necessary action.

C.D. be returned.
