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**ORDER BELOW EXH. 1**

The present is filed by the applicants under section 125(1) of The Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (in Short 'Cr.P.C').

2. Perused record it appears that, applicants have filed the present application on 07/06/2022. Thereafter the applicants has not taken any effective steps in the matter since 30/01/2025. Subsequently vide order below Exh.1 dated 10/04/2025 the matter was put up for necessary order as applicants were absent and no steps was taken by them. It appears from roznama that the present matter is pending for taking effective steps since 30/01/2025. The applicant and her Ld. Advocate are absent from 30/01/2025 to till date.

3. Subsequently the matter was kept for Dismissal order on 29/05/2025 and lastly today. The applicants and their Ld. Advocate failed to proceed with the matter inspite of sufficient and reasonable opportunity. Today also applicants and Ld. Advocate for applicant called out repeatedly in the first session as well as in second session but they did not appear before Court. Thus, it seems that, applicants is not interested to proceed the matter actively and effectively. The applicant has not taken any initiate to proceed with the matter.

4. Considering the fact and circumstances it seems that, there is no

possibility of applicants of appearing and taking effective steps to proceed with the matter. No fruitful purpose would be served by keeping this unattended matter on record. The matter is of year 2022. Considering the entire fact and circumstance on record, it reveals that there is no ground to proceed further. Hence, this court passes the following order -

**ORDER**

The Cri. M.A. No. 55/2022 is dismissed for want of prosecution and for want of effective steps.
