## **ORDER**

Petition filed u/s.91 of Cr.PC to direct respondents/accused to produce the served copy of the statutory legal notice and office copy of their reply notice to be produced before the court.

Both sides heard. Perused entire records. The petitioner sought for the served copy of statutory legal notice and office copy of reply notice. The official liquidators clearly mentioned that the documents were not received by him.

The counter filed by A2 and A4 states that the official liquidator took charge of entire documents pertaining to the company. Therefore, both the A2 and A4 and the official liquidator had stated before this court that they do not possess the documents sought for. They cannot estop from this stand in future also.

No one can be forced to produce document which is not in their prosecution with this in view, this court considers that this petition could not be maintained. Accordingly, this petition is hereby dismissed in the interest of justice.
