This petition came before this Court for final hearing today in the presence of Thiru.R.Siva learned Counsel for the petitioner and of Thiru.R.Udhayanithi learned Public Prosecutor(I/c) for the respondent and heard either side and perusing all the records, this Court delivered the following.....

**ORDER**

Petition filed U/s. 482 of BNSS 2023. Petitioner/A1 prays extension of time for surrender as per order in CrI.M.P. No.102/2026, dated 19.1.2026 for the offences Punishable U/s. 191(2), 296(b), 115(2), 351(2) of BNS 2023 and Section 4 of TNPHW Act in the case in Cr. No.454/2025 of respondent Police Station.

The learned counsel for the petitioner/A1 submitted that the petitioner/A1 has already been granted anticipatory bail by this Hon'ble Court vide order in CrI.M.P. No. 102/2026 with condition to surrender before the learned Jurisdictional Magistrate within 15 days from the day of order without fail, but, due viral fever, this petitioner unable to arrange sureties in time and prays time for extension for surrender.

The learned Public Prosecutor has raised objection that the petitioner not abided the condition imposed by this Hon'ble Court within the time stipulated and hence the petition may be dismissed.

Rival contentions are taken into consideration. Records perused. The learned counsel for the petitioner represented that due viral fever, this petitioner unable to arrange sureties in time and prays time for extension for surrender. The learned Public Prosecutor has not raised any serious objection. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case,

this court is inclined to extend 2 weeks time for surrender. Accordingly, the petitioner/A1 is hereby directed to surrender before the learned Additional District Munsif Cum Judicial Magistrate, Vendasandur, on or before 26.3.2026 and execute a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the said Magistrate without fail and also the petitioner/A1 is directed to comply the other conditions as already imposed by this Court in Crl.M.P. No.102/2026 without any deviation and this petition is allowed accordingly.
