ORDER

As per conditional order passed by this Court in the same Cr.M.P.No. 617/2026 dated 12.3.2026, the petitioner/appellant deposited 10% of the cheque amount before the learned Judicial Magistrate No.I, Dindigul on 12.3.2026 and has filed the receipt for the same before this Court today.

Conditional order complied. Records perused. Considering the fact that evidence has to be appreciated for adjudication in the appeal, nature and facts and circumstances of the case, this Court is inclined to suspend the sentence and enlarge the Petitioner/accused on bail with condition and thereby the sentence of imprisonment imposed by the learned Judicial Magistrate No.I, Dindigul in C.C. No.472/2021 on 10.2.2026 is suspended till the disposal of the appeal in C.A.No.58/2026 and enlarge the petitioner/accused on bail on compliance of the following conditions.

1. The petitioner/accused should execute a bond for Rs.15,000/- with two sureties for a like sum each to the satisfaction of the learned Judicial Magistrate No.I, Dindigul.
2. The petitioner/accused should appear before the this court Sessions Judge, Dindigul on 08.06.2026 and on further hearings without fail.
