

**CrI.M.P. No.618/2026 .... continuation**

**ORDER**

In continuation of this Court order in the same Cr.M.P. No., dated 30.3.2026, this petition was posted today for production of acknowledgment for deposit of 10% of the cheque amount. On verification of records, it is clear that on 30.3.2026, this Court passed conditional order that the petitioner was directed to deposit 10% of the cheque amount before the learned Jurisdictional Magistrate on or before 20.4.2026 and also directed to call in open Court on 21.4.2026. When this petition came before this Court on the hearing 21.4.2026, on the side of the petitioner no representation and today also no representation on petitioner's side. The learned Public Prosecutor has raised objection that the petitioner has not abided the condition imposed by this Hon'ble Court, hence the petition may be dismissed. Already this Court gave sufficient time for payment. Further, this Court has already passed conditional order. But, the petitioner has not complied the condition imposed by this Court and no representation on the side of petitioner. Considering the above aspects and the facts and circumstances of the case, this Court is not inclined to grant allow this petition. Hence, this petition is dismissed.
