This petition came before this Court for final hearing today in the presence of Thiru.J.Satheeshkumar, learned Counsel for the petitioners and of Thiru.P.Mahendran learned Public Prosecutor for the respondent and heard either side and perusing all the records, this Court delivered the following.....

ORDER

Petition filed U/s. 483 of BNS. petitioner/accused prays to Relaxation the condition imposed against him by this Court in Crl.M.P. No.544/2026 dated 4.3.2026.

Heard both sides. Records perused.

The petitioner was enlarged on bail by this Court in Crl.M.P. No. 544/2026 dated 4.3.2026 with a condition to appear and sign before the S.H.O., respondent P.S. daily at 10.00 a.m. for 30 days. The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that petitioner faced great stake to appear before the respondent P.S. which is 30 kms. away from his native and he prays to relax the condition totally. The learned Public Prosecutor has raised serious objection that a case was registered against this petitioner/accused for the offences punishable U/S. 27(2) of Arms Act and 353(2) of BNS 2023 @ 25(1)(a) of Arms Act and that if the condition is relaxed there is more chance of absconding. The reason put forth by the petitioner is not acceptable one. Considering the nature and the facts and circumstances of the case, this Court is not inclined to allow this petition. Hence, the petition is dismissed.
