This petition came before this Court for final hearing today in the presence of Thiru.S.Sivabalan, learned Counsel for the petitioner and of Thiru.R.Udhayanithi learned Public Prosecutor(I/c) for the respondent and heard either side and perusing all the records, this Court delivered the following.....

ORDER

The petitioner/accused has filed this petition U/s.482 of BNSS 2023 to grant him anticipatory bail for the case filed before the Dindigul Taluk P.S. in Cr. No. Not known for the alleged offences punishable U/s. 296(b), 115(1), 351(3) of BNS 2023.

It is stated in the petition that the petitioner/accused came to know that a criminal case has been registered for the alleged offences punishable U/s. 296(b), 115(1), 351(3) of BNS 2023 and the respondent police wanted him for arrest.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the defacto complainant Divya lodged a complaint against the petitioner for the alleged offences punishable U/s. 296(b), 115(1), 351(3) of BNS 2023, but, that the petitioner is an innocent and he has not committed any offence as alleged, before one year the defacto complainant pledged his jewels to the petitioner and borrowed amount, when the petitioner asked to repay the borrowed amount there arose quarrel between them, that in order to take revenge, the defacto complainant foisted this false complaint against this petitioner, that this petitioner has permanent abode and therefore there is no chance for absconding, that the petitioner apprehends for arrest and he prays for anticipatory bail.

It is represented by the learned Public Prosecutor that no CSR is pending and no FIR registered as against this petitioner as of now.

Heard both sides. Records perused. Considering the fact that no CSR is pending and no FIR registered as against this petitioner as of now as stated by the learned Public Prosecutor and upon considering the facts and circumstances of the case, this Court is not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner/accused at this stage. Hence, the petition is dismissed.
