Both parties present and they have agreed for amicable settlement and filed terms of compromise with free will and volition.

Matter is settled for **Rs.2,20,000/-**

AWARD U/S 21 OF THE LEGAL SERVICES AUTHORITIES ACT, 1987

1. The petition is filed by the petitioners claiming compensation of Rs.5,00,000/-.
2. At the intervention of Lok Adalath the following award is passed.

The Petitioner agreed to receive the compensation of **Rs.2,20,000/- (Rupees Two Lakhs twenty thousand only)** in full and final settlement of the claim.

- A) Respondent/Insurance company is directed to deposit the said claim within 30 days from the date of the Award.
- B) On such deposit petitioner is permitted to withdraw entire amount of **Rs.2,20,000/- (Rupees Two Lakhs twenty thousand only)** by filing an application.

In case the respondent/insurance company doesn't deposit the awarded amount within a period of 30 days, the awarded amount shall carry interest at 7.5.% per annum from the date of award.

Both parties have affixed their signatures/thumb impressions in evidence of there off with free consent for the terms of the award.
