This petition came before this Court for final hearing today in the presence of Thiru. P.Cheena Krishnan, the learned Advocate for the petitioners and of Thiru.R.Udhayanithi, In-Charge for the learned Public Prosecutor for the respondent and heard either side and on perusing all the records, this Court delivered the following.....

ORDER

1. The petition is filed U/S.482 of BNSS 2023 seeking anticipatory bail.

2. Nitty-Gritty of the prosecution case is as follows :-

On 26.05.2026 at 11.00 P.M. the petitioners abused the complainant and his family members in filthy language. Further they set fire two wheeler belongs to the complainant and completely damaged it. Therefore, case registered against the petitioners U/s 296(b), 329(4), 326, 324(4) and 351(3) of B.N.S.Act,2023.

3. The prosecution filed objection.

4. Heard both sides and records perused.

5. The point for determination is whether the petitioners/accused can be enlarged on anticipatory bail?

6. Answer :-

The First Information Report would reveal that the petitioners abused the complainant in filthy language and set fire his two wheeler resulted in two wheeler completely gutted. The damage caused by the petitioners is at Rs.25,000/- The prosecution submitted that if released on bail, the petitioners would commit similar offence against the complainant and the investigation is still underway. Having considered the serious nature of the offence and the investigation is underway, it is not appropriate to release the petitioners on bail at initial stage of investigation. So the petition is liable to be dismissed. Accordingly, the point is answered.

In fine, Petition is dismissed.
