This petition came before this Court for final hearing today in the presence of Thiru. C.Gurumoorthy, the learned Advocate for the petitioners and of Thiru.R.Udhayanithi, In-Charge for the learned Public Prosecutor for the respondent and heard either side and on perusing all the records, this Court delivered the following.....

ORDER

1. The petition is filed U/S.482 of BNSS 2023 seeking anticipatory bail.

2. Nitty-Gritty of the prosecution case is as follows :-

On 28/05/2026 at 4.50 P.M. on the bank of river the petitioners prevented temple karagam being immersed in the river and assaulted the complainant with hands as well as intimidated him with dire consequences. Therefore, case registered against the petitioners U/s 191(2), 296(b), 115(2) and 351(2) of B.N.S.Act,2023.

3. The prosecution filed objection.

4. Heard both sides and records perused.

5. The point for determination is whether the petitioners/accused can be enlarged on anticipatory bail?

6. Answer :-

The First Information Report would prima facie show that the petitioners alleged to have committed offence U/s 191(2), 296(b) and 115(2) of B.N.S.Act,2023. The above offences committed by the petitioners are bailable one. So the petitioners cannot seek anticipatory bail for bailable offences. Ideo, the petition is not maintainable and liable to be dismissed. Accordingly the point is answered.

In fine, the petition is dismissed with a direction to the petitioners to surrender before the Judicial Magistrate Court No.I at Dindigul within 10 days from the date of order and obtain bail.
