This petition came before this Court for final hearing today in the presence of Thiru.S.Anbuhariharan, the learned Counsel for the petitioner and of Thiru.R.Udhayanithi, In-Charge for the learned Public Prosecutor for the respondent and heard either side and on perusing all the records, this Court delivered the following.....

ORDER

1. The petition is filed U/S.483 of BNSS 2023 seeking bail.

2. Nitty-Gritty of the prosecution case is as follows :-

On 03.05.2026 at 11.30 P.M. the petitioner and the co-ccused intercepted the bus bearing registration number KA 57 F 0257 at Dhadikombu Jio petrol bunk and abused the driver. Further they damaged the windshield glass and wiper worth Rs.50,000/- Therefore, case registered against the petitioners U/s 296(b), 126(2) of B.N.S. Act,2023 and Sec. 5 of T.N.P.P.D.L.Act.

3. The prosecution filed objection. Heard both sides.

4. The point for determination is that can bail be granted to the petitioner?

5. Answer :-

The Counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioners questioned the over speeding of bus which was driven by the complainant. Following which the incident took place. Further it is alleged in the F.I.R. that the petitioner and the co-accused caused damage to the bus for sum of

Rs.50,000/- which is considered to be serious. The counsel for the petitioner also submitted that he is ready to pay sum of Rs.50,000/- towards damage. Having considered the above grounds, I inclined to release the petitioner on conditional bail.

6. Ideo, it is ordered that the petitioner shall deposit sum of Rs.50,000/- in to Judicial Magistrate Court No.II at Dindigul within 15 days. Further the petitioner shall be released on bail on his executing a bond for a sum of Rs.15,000/- with two sureties each for like sum. The following conditions are imposed upon the petitioner.

1. The petitioner shall appear in person before the SHO, Dhadikombu Police station daily at 10.00 A.M. for a period of 15 days and thereafter shall appear before the Investigating Officer as and when required.
2. The petitioner shall not contact the prosecution witnesses either directly or through electronic medium.
3. The petitioner shall furnish his mobile phone number and his residential address by filling affidavit before Court.
4. If there is any violation of condition, the Investigation Officer is within his discretion to approach the Court concerned for cancellation of bail as per the ruling of the Hon'ble Supreme court reported in P.K.Shaji/Vs/State of Kerala, (2005)AIR S.C.W.5560.
