This petition came before this Court for final hearing today in the presence of Thiru.M.Kannappan, the learned Counsel for the petitioner and of Thiru.R.Udhayanithi, In-Charge for the learned Public Prosecutor for the respondent and heard either side and on perusing all the records, this Court delivered the following.....

ORDER

1. The petition is filed U/S.483 of BNSS 2023 seeking bail.

2. Nitty-Gritty of the prosecution case is as follows :-

On 23.05.2026 at 7.15 A.M. at Murugan Temple, the petitioner with an intention to kill the complainant rammed his Tanker Lorry bearing Regn.No. TN 12 S 5253 against the two wheeler driven by the complainant. Thereafter the petitioner intimidated with dire consequences. Therefore, final report laid against him u/s.115(2), 351(2), 109 of BNS.

3. The prosecution filed objection. Heard both sides.

4. The point for determination is that Whether the bail be granted to the petitioner/ accused ?

5. Answer :-

The FIR would prima facie reveals that on 23.05.2026 at 7.15 A.M. the petitioner who was driven the Tanker Lorry bearing Regn.No. TN 12 S 5253 has dashed against the two wheeler driven by the complainant. Thereupon the petitioner physically assaulted the complainant and intimidated him. Further, it came to light that there was a civil dispute between the petitioner and the complainant for a long time. The prosecution submitted that if

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the petitioner is released on bail, he would tamper the prosecution witnesses and abscond. Having considered the gravity of the offence , I am not inclined to release the petitioner on bail and the petition is liable to be dismissed. Accordingly the point is answered.

In fine, the petition is dismissed.
