Petition dated 14.07.2026 through e-filed and U/s. 482 of BNSS seeks anticipatory bail to the petitioner/accused.

This petition came before this Court for final hearing today in the presence of Thiru.S.Yogesh Pandi, the learned Counsel for the petitioner and of Thiru.T.Sivachandran, the learned Public Prosecutor for the respondent and heard either side and on perusing all the records, this Court delivered the following.....

ORDER

This petitioner/accused (A1) seeks anticipatory bail for the alleged offence U/s 296(b), 115(2), 118(1) and 351(3) of BNS Act,2023.

2. The learned Counsel appearing for the petitioner/accused (A1) would submit that the petitioner did not involve in this case incident as alleged by prosecution; false case has been foisted against the petitioner/accused; if he is released on anticipatory bail he will abide the conditions of this Court and that he may be released on anticipatory bail.

3. On the other hand, the learned Public Prosecutor contended that investigation is pending; injured person was treated as out patient; petitioner has already not involved in previous case incident; if the petitioner is released on anticipatory bail, he will abscond and tamper the prosecution witnesses and that petition may be dismissed.

4. Upon hearing both side arguments and on perusal of records, it is seen that at the time of alleged incident the petitioner in an inebriated mood abused the defacto complainant in filthy language; attacked him by broken beer bottle and threatened him with dire consequences. It is fairly conceded on prosecution that injured person was treated as out patient, no any previous case is reported against the petitioners/accused.

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5. Considering the nature of offence, no any previous case is reported against the petitioner/accused and in the interest of Justice, this Court is inclined to release the petitioner/accused on anticipatory bail on following conditions.

1. That the petitioner/accused (A1) in the event of his arrest or surrender before the **learned District Munsif-cum-Judicial Magistrate, Athoor** within 15 days from the date of this order and on such arrest or surrender the petitioner is ordered to be enlarged on anticipatory bail on his executing a bond for a sum of **Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand)** with two sureties for a like sum; **if the** petitioner/accused (A1) not surrendered within 15 days from the date of this order this anticipatory bail shall stands cancelled automatically.s
2. The sureties shall affix their photograph and Left Thumb impression in the surety bond and the Magistrate may obtain a copy of their Aadhar Card or Bank Pass Book to ensure their identity.
3. The petitioner/accused shall (A1) appear and sign before the **respondent Police station daily at 10.00 a.m. for a period of 2 weeks without fail.**
4. The petitioner/accused (A1) shall not tamper with evidence or witness either during investigation or trial.
5. The petitioner/accused (A1) shall not abscond either during investigation or trial.
6. On breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioners in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioners released on anticipatory bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in P.K. Shaji Vs. State of Kerala [(2005) AIR SCW 5560].
7. If the petitioner/accused (A1) thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be registered under **section 269 of BNS.**
