Petition dated 13.07.2026 through e-filed and U/s. 483 of BNSS seeks custody bail to the petitioner/accused.

This petition came before this Court for final hearing today in the presence of Thiru. L.Kathiravan, the learned Counsel for the petitioner and of Thiru.T.Sivachandran, the learned Public Prosecutor for the respondent and heard either side and on perusing all the records, this Court delivered the following.....

ORDER

1. This petitioner/ accused (A1) seeks bail for the alleged offences U/s 296(b) of BNS Act,2023 and U/s 27(1) of Arms Act.
2. The prosecution case is that the defacto complainant is S.I. of Police attached to the respondent P.S.; that on 02.07.2026 at 10.30 a.m. when he along with police party made surveillance for prevention of crime control in the place of occurrence; the petitioner and co-accused persons uttered obscene words towards the public and created panic with sharp edged swords; on seeing the police party, the accused try to escape, but the respondent police surrounded them and seized 3 sharp edged swords from the petitioner and co-accused persons, hence the case.
3. The learned Counsel appearing for the petitioner/ accused (A1) would submit that the petitioner is undergoing incarceration from 02.07.2026; that the petitioner did not involve in this case incident as alleged by prosecution; false case has been foisted against the petitioner; if he is released on bail, he will abide the conditions of this Court and that he may be released on bail.
4. On the other hand, the learned Public Prosecutor contended that investigation is pending; the petitioner/accused has not already involved in previous case incident; if he is

released on bail, he will abscond and tamper the prosecution witnesses and that petition may be dismissed.

5. Upon hearing both side arguments and on perusal of contents of FIR, it is seen that in the place of incident the accused uttered obscene words towards public, created panic with weapons and police party seized 3 sharp edged swords from the accused. It is fairly conceded on Prosecution that no any previous case is reported against the petitioner/accused.

6. Considering the nature of offence, period of incarceration and also in the interest of justice, this Court is inclined to release the petitioner/accused on bail on following conditions;

(I) the petitioner/accused (A1) is ordered to be released on bail on executing a bond for a sum of **Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand)** with two sureties for a like sum to the satisfaction of **learned Judicial Magistrate, Palani;**

1. the sureties shall affix their photographs and Left Thumb impression in the surety bond and the Magistrate may obtain a copy of their Aadhar Card or Bank Pass Book to ensure their identity.
 2. the petitioner/accused shall appear and sign before the **respondent police daily at 10.00 a.m for a period of 3 weeks;**
 3. the petitioner/accused shall not tamper with evidence or witness either during investigation or trial.
 4. the petitioner/accused shall not abscond either during investigation or trial.
 5. On breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioner released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in P.K. Shaji Vs. State of Kerala [(2005) AIR SCW 5560].
 6. If the accused thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be registered U/S.269 of BNS
