**This is an application filed on behalf of the applicant/accused Sahil for the release of his seized mobile phone.**

1. I heard submissions on the present application.
2. Ld. Counsel for the applicant/accused submitted that during the personal search of the applicant/accused, his one mobile phone make Redmi 13 C was seized from him by the police officials. Ld. Counsel further submitted that the said mobile phone is not a case property and the same is no more required for any further investigation and thus, learned counsel for the applicant/accused prayed for release of the same.
3. Reply to the application has been received from the IO. As per the report, IO has no objection if the said mobile phone is released to its rightful owner.
4. Record perused.
5. Taking into account the submissions and for the reasons mentioned in the application and further, the fact that IO has no objection, I deem it fit to release the mobile phone make Redmi 13C of the applicant/accused Sahil, as per personal search

memo to its registered/rightful owner, against proper receipt as per rules.
