Petition dated 16.07.2026 through offline and U/s. 430(1) of BNSS seeks Suspension of Sentence to the petitioner/accused.

This petition came before this Court for final hearing today in the presence of Thiru. S.Sarvagan Prabhu, the learned Counsel for the petitioner and of Thiru.T.Sivachandran, the learned Public Prosecutor for the respondent and heard either side and on perusing all the records, this Court delivered the following.....

ORDER

The petition has been filed U/S.430(i) of BNSS by the petitioner / accused to suspend the sentence passed against the petitioner by the learned Judicial Magistrate No.III, Dindigul in C.C.No.647/2022, dated 17.06.2026; the petitioner / accused was convicted and sentenced as follows; the accused to undergo R.I of six months for the offence U/s.279 of IPC, the accused to undergo R.I of three months (3 count) for the offence U/s. 337 of IPC and the accused to undergo R.I of six months (2 count) for the offence U/s. 338 of IPC and the accused sentenced to undergo R.I of one year for the offence U/s. 304(A) of IPC.

2. Notice given to the learned Public Prosecutor.

3. Heard Both sides. The petitioner had preferred an appeal as against the Judgment passed in C.C.No.647/2022 on the file of Judicial Magistrate Court No.III, Dindigul on 17.06.2026. The petitioner had raised several grounds of appeal in Crl.Appeal No.133/2026. The appeal could not be heard immediately. Only after hearing

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the arguments on both sides, the appeal can be decided. According to the petitioner he has arguable points and no fine was imposed against him. In such circumstances, the sentence passed against the petitioner can be suspended till the disposal of the appeal.

In the result, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on executing a bond for **Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties** for a like sum, to the satisfaction of the **learned Judicial Magistrate No.III, Dindigul on or before 30.07.2026** and the sentence is suspended till the disposal of Crl.Appeal No.133/2026.
