Petition filed seeking bail and U/s.480 BNSS to release the petitioners /accused 2 and 3 on bail.

This petition has been filed on behalf of petitioners /accused 2 and 3 U/s.480 of BNSS on 14.07.2026 by Petitioners /accused 2 and 3 counsel Mr. R. Kannan Advocate and Issued notice to Learned APP and concerned Police and upon perusal of petition, records and the objection filed by the respondent and upon hearing of both sides, this court delivers the following.

### **ORDER**

The petitioners / accused 2 and 3 are seeking release on bail for the offense alleged to have been committed by them U/s. 112(1), 303(2) BNS.

The Learned counsel for petitioners / accused 2 and 3 submitted that the Petitioners were arrested on 25.06.2026 and remanded to judicial custody. The petitioners / accused 2 and 3 were an innocent and not guilty of any offense. The petitioners / accused 2 and 3 are ready to furnish sureties as satisfaction of this court and also ready to abide any conditions imposed by this court. They has been falsely implicated in this case. The petitioners

/accused 2 and 3 were not likely to abscond or interfere with the investigation. Hence, the Petitioners may be enlarged on bail.

The learned APP submitted that the petitioners / accused 2 and 3 were released on bail, they may abscond and avoid trial proceedings and may commit same kind of offenses, tamper the evidence. Hence the learned APP vehemently opposed to release the petitioners / accused 2 and 3 on bail.

On perusal of records, it would be disclosed that the petitioners / accused 2 and 3 were remanded to judicial custody on 25.06.2026. This case has been registered against the petitioners / accused 2 and 3 alleged to have committed the offenses U/s. 112(1), 303(2) BNS. On considering the facts and circumstances of the case, there is a chance to tamper the evidence and there is a chance to commit same kind of offenses, Hence, this court is declined to enlarge petitioners / accused 2 and 3 on bail.

Accordingly, the bail petition is dismissed.
