Petition filed seeking bail and U/s.480 BNSS to release the petitioner /accused 4 on bail.

This petition has been filed on behalf of petitioner /accused 4 U/s.480 of BNSS on 16.07.2026 by Petitioner /accused 4 counsel Mr. M. Tamil Selvan Advocate and Issued notice to Learned APP and concerned Police and upon perusal of petition, records and the objection filed by the respondent and upon hearing of both sides, this court delivers the following.

ORDER

The petitioner / accused 4 is seeking release on bail for the offense alleged to have been committed by him U/s. 112(1), 303(2) BNS.

The Learned counsel for petitioner / accused 4 submitted that the Petitioner was arrested on 25.06.2026 and remanded to judicial custody. The petitioner / accused 4 was an innocent and not guilty of any offense. The petitioner / accused 4 is ready to furnish sureties as satisfaction of this court and also ready to abide any conditions imposed by this court. He has been falsely implicated in this case. The petitioner /accused 4 was not likely to abscond or interfere with the investigation. Hence, the Petitioner may be enlarged on bail.

The learned APP submitted that the petitioner / accused 4 was released on bail, he may abscond and avoid trial proceedings and may commit same kind of offenses, tamper the evidence. Hence the learned APP vehemently opposed to release the petitioner / accused 4 on bail.

On perusal of records, it would be disclosed that the petitioner / accused 4 was remanded to judicial custody on 25.06.2026. This case has registered against the petitioner / accused 4 alleged to have been committed the offenses U/s. 112(1), 303(2) BNS. On considering the facts and circumstances of the case, there is a chance to tamper the evidence and there is a chance to commit same kind of offenses, Hence, this court is declined to enlarge petitioner / accused 4 on bail.

Accordingly, the bail petition is dismissed.
