Petition filed seeking bail and U/s.480 of BNSS to release the petitioner /accused on bail.

This petition has been filed U/s.480 of BNSS on 07.11.2025 by Petitioner /accused counsel Tr.P.Jebarson raj. Issued notice to Learned APP and concerned Police. Reply received and on considering the contention raised by both sides and on perusal of case records, this court delivers the following.

#### ORDER

1. The petitioner / accused is seeking release on bail for the offense alleged to have been committed by him U/s. 379 of IPC in Cr.No.503/2021 of Taluk Police Station in C.C.No. 1069/2022.

2. The Learned counsel for petitioner / accused submitted that the Petitioner was arrested on 06.10.2025 on execution of NBW and remanded to judicial custody. The petitioner *accused is ready to furnish sureties as satisfaction of this court and also ready to abide any conditions imposed by this court. Further submitted that the petitioner is only breadwinner of his family.* The petitioner /accused is not likely to abscond during trial. Hence, the Petitioner may be enlarged on bail.

3. The learned APP submitted that if the petitioner/ accused is released on bail , he may again absconded and avoided the trial proceedings. Hence the learned APP vehemently opposed to release the accused on bail.

4. On perusal of records, it would disclosed that the petitioner/ accused was arrested on 06.10.2025 on execution of NBW and remanded to judicial custody. This case has registered against the petitioner/ accused alleged to has been committed the offenses U/s.379 of IPC. The petitioner accused NBW pending from 10.12.2024. On execution of NBW accused was remanded to judicial custody on 06.10.2025. Perused the records. On considering the facts and circumstances of the case and he is ready to furnish sureties. Hence, this court is inclined to enlarge petitioner/ accused on bail subject to following conditions.

5. In the result , the petitioner/ accused is ordered to be released on bail on his execution of bond for a sum of Rs.10000/- (Rupees ten thousand only ) and the petitioner accused shall produce two surety each for a like sum.

1. The petitioner on his release from prison shall report Concerned Police Station and sign every day at 10.30 A.M for 30 days.
2. The petitioner shall not abscond during trial.
3. If the petitioner thereafter abscond, a fresh FIR may be filed U/s 269 of BNS

Accordingly, the bail petition is allowed.
