ORDER (BELOW EXH.1)
(Passed on 28.07.2026)

Perused the application. Heard learned Advocate for the applicant. Present application has been filed on behalf of the applicant for issuance of legal heirship certificate under the provision of the Bombay Regulation, 1827.

2. It is the case of the applicant that applicant is wife of deceased Bhikoba Gopal Ranadive who died on 03.01.2026 at Gat 243, Flat A605, Magic City Co-op Soc, Moshi Alandi Road, Dadulgaon, Moshi Pune 412105. It is further contention of the applicant that except her, there are no other legal heirs of deceased Bhikoba Gopal Ranadive. She is in need of legal heirship certificate for official and non official purpose. Hence, the application.

3. Perusal of record shows that the applicant Surekha Bhikoba Randive examined herself at Exh.5. She reiterated contents of main application in her affidavit in lieu of examination in chief. The applicant has also filed death certificate of her husband Bhikoba Gopal Ranadive(Exh.12), verified copies of Adhar card and Pan Card of applicant Surekha(Exh.13 and Exh.14), verified copy official Gazate

about name of applicant (Exh.15) and verified copy of Adhar card of respondent No.1 (Exh.16) and verified copy of Adhar card of respondent No.2 (Exh.17) . The notice of application made by applicant has been issued through paper publication Punya Nagri dated 08/05/2026 which is at Exh.18, but no one appeared from public at large for taking objection to the present application. Citation notice (Exh.6) is also issued. The respondent No.1 is the daughter and respondent No.2 is the son of deceased Bhikoba Gopal Ranadive. Respondents have filed their No Objections at Exh.10 and Exh.11 for issuing heirship certificate in the name of applicant. Therefore, it appears that the contention of the applicant in the application for issuance of heirship certificate is remained uncontested and unchallenged.

4. In a proceedings for heirship certificate, the court is not required to determine title of the deceased to any property. It is required only to consider whether the persons claiming heirship certificate are the heirs of the deceased. Oral and documentary evidence produced by the applicant show that the applicant is the only legal representative of deceased Bhikoba Gopal Ranadive. Therefore, it would be desirable to issue legal heirship certificate in favour of the applicant. Hence, I pass following order.

ORDER

1. The application is allowed.
2. It is hereby directed that heirship certificate be issued in the name of applicant Surekha Bhikoba Randive as legal heir of deceased Bhikoba Gopal Ranadive.

3. The applicant is directed to furnish necessary court fee stamp in terms of provisions of Bombay Court Fees Act, 1870 within 30 days from the date of this order, if required.
