This petition is coming up before me for hearing on this day, in the presence of Learned Counsel for Petitioner, Thiru.L.Kathiravan Upon considering the submissions put forth and the upon perusal of the records and materials placed before, and having stood over for consideration till this date , this court delivers the following :

ORDER

1. This petition is filed under section 175 (3) BNSS seeking to direct the Inspector of Police, Oddanchatram Police Station, Dindigul District to register a First Information Report against the arrayed Accused for the offence criminal breach of trust U/s. 120(b), 420,406, 294(b), 323,324,506(2) IPC,

2. Petitioner present . Heard the Petitioner side. Material records perused. Upon perusal of the affidavit and the complaint, it is alleged that after occurrence of offence she was admitted in hospital. Which admitted in hospital the 2nd respondent here in had inquired but no action taken till date subsequently the Petitioner / Complainant has sent the complaint on 31.05.2024 through RPAD to the Inspector of Police Oddanchatram Police Station, and has thereafter also sent a copy to Superintendent of Police, Dindigul, through RPAD on 31.05.2024. No proper action was taken. Hence the petitioner has complied with the requirements u/s.173(1) and 173(4) of BNSS.

3. Upon perusal of the records and upon considering the facts and circumstances, Discharge summary of petitioner the court finds that prima facie case made out against the arrayed respondents. Hence in the interest of Justice, this complaint is forwarded to the SHO, Oddanchatram P.S, u/s 175 (3) BNSS to investigate the case and file a report and if cognizable offence is made out , the SHO , Oddanchatram P.S., is directed to proceed the case in accordance with law. SHO is directed to follow the guidelines of the Hon'ble Apex Court in Lalita Kumari V Govt of UP & Ors and to conduct a preliminary enquiry and if the fact and circumstances of the case warrants, to proceed the case in accordance with law and file the report before this court on or before 27.03.2026.

In result, this petition is allowed accordingly.
