This is an application under Section 482 BNSS for grant of anticipatory bail moved on behalf of accused/applicant Ali Hussain.

Present: Sh. Pankaj Bhatia, Ld. Addl. PP for the State.
Sh. Raid Hoda along with Sh. Sahu Shambhu, Counsel for accused/applicant.

1. Present anticipatory bail application is filed by the applicant in the instant FIR No.896/2025 registered at PS Narela Industrial Area under Section 21/29 NDPS Act.

2. Arguments heard. Record perused.

3. Perusal of the record depicts that this court has already given its detailed findings while adjudicating the anticipatory bail application vide order dated 13.11.2025. Further, the applicant has approached the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi by way of moving an application seeking anticipatory bail, which was also dismissed as withdrawn vide order dated 12.02.2026.

4. Suffice to note herein that nothing has changed from the dismissal of the said order. Therefore, there is no merit in the argument raised by the Counsel for the applicant. Hence, I do not find any reason to exercise discretion in favour of accused/applicant. In view of the above facts and circumstances of the case, I am of the considered view that no ground is made out for grant of bail to accused/applicant Ali Hussain. Therefore, the application moved on behalf of the accused/applicant Ali Hussain stands dismissed.

5. Nothing in this order shall tantamount to an expression of opinion on the merits of the case during trial.
