State Vs. Balwinder Singh

Ld. APP has put in appearance on behalf of the State.
Reply to bail application has not been filed but Ld. APP for the State
has strongly opposed the bail application.

As per allegations being levelled against the accused, on
04.10.2022 accused/applicant Balwinder Singh along-with co-accused
Gulab Singh was apprehended by police party headed by ASI Jagsir
Singh, while in possession of 3 Gram Heroin.

Heard. Accused has committed offence punishable under
Section 21(A) of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act,
1985. Accused is already in custody since 04.10.2022. Presentation of
the challan would certainly take considerable time. Moreover, modern
law of jurisprudence leans towards granting bail than jail. If the
accused is kept behind the bars then it would be burden on State
exchequer. Keeping in view the facts and circumstances and in the
interest of justice, present bail application is allowed to the effect that
accused is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds in
the sum of Rs.50,000/- with one surety in the like amount. The
application stands disposed of accordingly. Requisite bail/surety bonds
have been furnished, which are accepted and attested. Release warrant
of accused Balwinder Singh be issued forthwith. Paper be attached
with remand papers.
