

COMA-1002-2022 Shifali Bansal Vs. Ashwani Bansal

Present :- Sh. Manish Kumar Batta counsel for complainant.

Complaint against respondents no. 3 to 6 dismissed.

Complaint under section 12 of the D.V. Act has been received by allocation. It be checked and registered.

Perusal of the record shows that the respondent no.1 is husband, respondent No.2 is mother-in-law, respondent No. 3 to 5 are sisters-in-law of the applicant. Relationship between complainant and respondent No.6 has not been specified. It is forthcoming from the record that respondents No.3 to 5 are married and reside at village Mehal Kalan, district Ludhiana and village Bargadi, distt. Faridkot, respectively. Respondent No.6 is resident of Tapa Mandi. As per Section 2 (s) of Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, 2005, respondents No. 3 to 6 never resided in a shared household with the complainant and thus, domestic relationship as per Section 2 (f) of the Act does not exist between the complainant and respondents No. 3 to 6. As such, the present application is not maintainable against them. In view of above discussion, present application stands dismissed against respondents No.3 to 6. Notice to respondents No. 1 and 2 be issued for 11.05.2022. Dasti be taken. One set of summons be served through Protection Officer. Report of the Protection Officer be called for for the date fixed.
