This application coming on 03.06.2026 before me for final hearing in the presence of the Thiru.S.Saravanan,B.Com.,B.L., and Thiru.M.Andidurai,B.Sc.,LLB., Advocates appearing for petitioner/accused and APP appearing for state, upon hearing arguments of both parties, perusing the records and having stood over for consideration till this day, this court delivers the following.

ORDER

1. The petitioner / accused filed a bail application under section 480 of BNSS for the alleged offences U/s.4(1)(C) r/w 4(1)(B) of TNP Act Learned Counsel appearing for the petitioner / accused would contend that the petitioner / accused is innocent and no way connected for the above said alleged offence. The learned Counsel would further submit that the accused was falsely implicated in this case and the petitioner / accused was arrested and remanded on 15.05.2026 there is no previous case against the petitioner/ Accused and he is ready to furnish substantial sureties if he is released on bail, therefore prayed for releasing the petitioner / accused on bail. This Bail Application is 2nd Petition.

2. In this petition reply received from the prosecution and stating in the reply that the case investigation is pending. If the petitioner/accused released on bail, he may be abscond, tamper the witnesses. In this earlier Stage investigation if this Accused in released on bail he may indulge in similar offence and deter investigation. Accused involved previous case in Cr.No.89/2026 of Marandahalli Police Station. Hence strongly objected to release the accused on bail.

03. This court carefully considered the rival submissions made by both side. On perusal of records, it is found that the petitioner/accused charged under sections 4(1)(C) r/w 4(1)(B) of TNP Act and he was remanded to judicial custody on 15.05.2026. The prosecution stated as the case investigation is pending and the investigation is at budding stage. If at this stage the petitioner/accused is released on bail, it would seriously prejudice the interest of the prosecution. The petitioner may tamper the witness and abscond from local jurisdiction. In these circumstances, considering the nature of the case, gravity of the offences and objection raised by the prosecution, period of remand, this court is not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner/accused and accordingly this petition is dismissed.

In the result, this bail application stands dismissed.
