	State Vs. Sunil Kathode

Order below Exh. 1
(Delivered on 28.07.2026)

The accused is present. He voluntarily pleaded guilty. Accused stands prosecuted for the commission of offence punishable under Section 353, 324, 332, 309, 506 of the Indian Penal Code and 85 of The Bombay Prohibition Act. Initially, accused pleads not guilty when my predecessor has framed charge against him. In the meanwhile, the prosecution has examined three witnesses. But, today accused and informant has filed pursis at Exh. 37 along with affidavit Exh. 38 intimating that they have settled the matter and as such the informant do not want to proceed with the matter at this stage. Hence, today accused pleaded guilty voluntarily for the offence punishable under Section 353, 324, 332, 309, 506 of the Indian Penal Code and 85 of The Bombay Prohibition Act through his learned counsel. I accept the plead guilty of accused and hold him guilty for the aforesaid offences. Heard, the learned AGP for the State and the learned counsel for accused. Heard, accused on the point of sentence. He prayed for leniency be shown to him on the ground that, he is only earning member of his family. Therefore, lenient view be taken. In the result, I pass the following order :

O R D E R	
1.	Accused Sunil Maroti Kathode is hereby convicted of

	the offence punishable under Sections 353 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 vide Section 252 of the Bhartiya Nagrik Suraksha Sanhita 2023 and he is sentenced to suffer Till Rising of Court and to pay fine of ₹. 300/- (Rupees Three Hundred Only) and in default of payment of fine he shall suffer simple imprisonment for Two (2) days.
2.	Accused Sunil Maroti Kathode is hereby convicted of the offence punishable under Sections 332 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 vide Section 252 of the Bhartiya Nagrik Suraksha Sanhita 2023 and he is sentenced to suffer Till Rising of Court and to pay fine of ₹. 300/- (Rupees Three Hundred Only) and in default of payment of fine he shall suffer simple imprisonment for two (2) day.
3.	Accused Sunil Maroti Kathode is hereby convicted of the offence punishable under Sections 324 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 vide Section 252 of the Bhartiya Nagrik Suraksha Sanhita 2023 and he is sentenced to suffer Till Rising of Court and to pay fine of ₹. 200/- (Rupees Two Hundred Only) and in default of payment of fine he shall suffer simple imprisonment for one (1) day.
4.	Accused Sunil Maroti Kathode is hereby convicted of the offence punishable under Sections 309 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 vide Section 252 of the Bhartiya Nagrik Suraksha Sanhita 2023 and he is sentenced to suffer Till Rising of Court and to pay fine of ₹. 200/- (Rupees Two Hundred Only) and in default of payment of fine he shall suffer simple imprisonment for one (1) day.
5.	Accused Sunil Maroti Kathode is hereby convicted of the offence punishable under Sections 506 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 vide Section 252 of the Bhartiya Nagrik Suraksha Sanhita 2023 and he is sentenced to suffer Till Rising of Court and to pay

	fine of ₹. 200/- (Rupees Two Hundred Only) and in default of payment of fine he shall suffer simple imprisonment for one (1) day.
6.	Accused Sunil Maroti Kathode is hereby convicted of the offence punishable under Section 85(1) of The Bombay Prohibition Act vide Section 252 of the Bhartiya Nagrik Suraksha Sanhita 2023 and he is sentenced to suffer Till Rising of Court and to pay fine of ₹. 100/- (Rupees One Hundred Only) and in default of payment of fine he shall suffer simple imprisonment for one (1) day.
7.	All sentenced shall run concurrently.
8.	Accused shall surrender his bail bonds.
9.	i) Seized muddemal i.e. Topaz platinum blade, as per seizure memo/seizure panchnama being worthless, be destroyed after appeal period is over. ii) Seized muddemal i.e. Khaki colour shirt as per seizure memo/seizure panchnama be given to the informant Vishnu Balasaheb Bhise, after appeal period is over. iii) Seized muddemal i.e. khaki pant, as per seizure memo/seizure panchnama be given to the informant Vishnu Balasaheb Bhise, after appeal period is over. iv) Seized muddemal i.e. yellow colour shirt, as per seizure memo/seizure panchnama be given to the informant Vishnu Balasaheb Bhise, after appeal period is over. v) Seized muddemal i.e. white colour handkerchief, as per seizure memo/seizure panchnama be given to the informant Vishnu Balasaheb Bhise, after appeal period is over.

10.	Matter is disposed off accordingly.
