Petition dated 31.01.2024 and 07.02.2024 filed under **S.389(1)** CrPC, praying to suspend the sentence of imprisonment imposed upon the petitioner/appellant/accused in STC No.195/2022 dated 06.01.2024 on the file of the Court of Judicial Magistrate, Fast Track Court No.II, Erode.

This petition coming on this day for hearing before me in the presence of Thiru.A.S.Nallasivam, Advocate for the petitioner and upon hearing the arguments on the side of the petitioner, this court made the following

ORDER

Heard the learned petitioner's counsel.

Claiming an order suspending the execution of sentence of imprisonment passed in STC No.195/2022 by judgment dated 06.01.2024 against the petitioner/appellant/accused wherein the trial court has found guilt of the petitioner/appellant/accused for an offence punishable under S.138 of Negotiable

Instruments Act, 1881, and imposed sentence to undergo simple imprisonment for three months and ordered her to pay a sum of Rs.2,50,000/- towards compensation to the respondent/complainant under S.357(3) CrPC, in default, to undergo simple imprisonment for one month, the petitioner/appellant/accused has filed this application under S.389(1) CrPC.

The petitioner/appellant/accused had failed to appear before the trial court on the date of judgment, that therefore, NBW has been issued against her and the same is pending for execution.

Aggrieved by the judgment of conviction and sentence, the petitioner/appellant/accused has filed an Appeal in CA No. 61/2024.

Pending the Appeal, the petitioner/appellant/accused seeks suspension of sentence for the reason that she has good chance to succeed in the appeal.

Learned counsel for the petitioner/appellant/accused has raised certain relevant issues and arguable points which have to be dealt with only at the time of final hearing. The petitioner/appellant/accused is convicted by the trial court for three months and the petitioner/appellant/accused have a right to effectively contest the appeal. In the above said reasons, this court is inclined to suspend the sentence imposed on the petitioner/appellant/accused by the trial court in STC No.195/2022 by judgment dated 06.01.2024.

In the result,

(a) the execution of sentence of imprisonment in STC No.195/2022 dated 06.01.2024 on the file of the court of Judicial Magistrate, Fast Track Court No.II, Erode, is suspended till the appeal is disposed of, with the following conditions,

(i) that 20% of the cheque amount (less if any of the amount paid under S.143A of NI Act) is ordered to be deposited before the trial court by the petitioner/appellant/accused in terms of S.148 of Negotiable Instruments Act within a period of 60 days from the date of this order, failing which this order of suspension of execution of sentence of the said imprisonment shall stand vacated automatically, and

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(ii) that the petitioner/appellant/accused, within 15 days from the date of such deposit of 20% of the cheque amount, has to execute a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- with two sureties for the like sum each to the satisfaction of the learned Judicial Magistrate, Fast Track Court No.II, Erode, and

(b) the learned Judicial Magistrate, Fast Track Court No.II, Erode, shall follow the procedures laid down under S.148 of NI Act in respect of the amount so deposited.
