2. Offence complained

:- U/sec.279,336 of I.P.C. & Sec.184, 122/177 of M.V.Act.

3. Particular of Offence :-

That on 24/4/2022 at about 16:30 hours, at Cadet Rd, North Band Mahim Mumbai, you accused was/were found driving your vehicle, so rashly or negligently as to endanger human life and personal safety of others and thereby committed an offence punishable u/sec.279 of I.P.C. and within my cognizance.

That on the abovementioned date, time and place you accused drove the vehicle so rashly or negligently as to endanger human life or personal safety of others and thereby committed an offence punishable u/sec.336 of IPC and within my cognizance.

That on above mentioned date, time and place you accused drove your Motor vehicle at speed or in manner which is dangerous to the public or which causes sense of alarm to other road users and thereby committed an offence punishable u/sec.184 of Motor Vehicles Act and within my cognizance.

Lastly on above mentioned date, time and place you accused to remain at rest your motor vehicle on public place in such a position as to cause or likely to cause danger, obstruction or undue inconvenience to other users of the public place and thereby committed an offence punishable u/sec.122/177 of Motor Vehicles Act and within my cognizance.

ORDER

1. The accused is/are alleged to have committed offence u/sec.279, 336 of IPC and 184 of M.V.Act. The accused has/have pleaded guilty voluntarily when the consequences of pleading guilty were explained to him/them. Thus, the accused will have to be convicted.

2. The learned APP argued for maximum punishment. However, there is no evidence of the previous conviction of the accused under the said sections available on record.

3. Heard the accused on the point of sentence. He stated that he is only earning member in his family. His economic conditions is not sound. His family is totally dependent on him. He further stated that it is his first offence and he assured that he will not commit any offence in future.

4. Considering the plea of the accused following order is passed.

ORDER

i) The accused is hereby convicted under Sec.252 for the offence punishable u/sec.279 of Indian Penal Code and sentenced to pay fine of **Rs.1,000/- only/each(Rupees One Thousand only/each)** and in default of payment of fine to suffer simple imprisonment for five days.

ii) The accused is hereby convicted under Sec.252 for the offence punishable u/sec.336 of Indian Penal Code and sentenced to pay fine of **Rs.200/- only/each(Rupees Two Hundred only/each)** and in default of payment of fine to suffer simple imprisonment for five days.

iii) The accused is hereby convicted under Sec.252 for the offence u/sec.184 of M.V.Act and sentenced to pay fine of **Rs.3,000/-(Rupees Three Thousand only)** and in default of payment of fine to suffer simple imprisonment for five days.

iii) The accused is hereby convicted under Sec.252 for the offence u/sec.122 punishable u/sec.177 of M.V.Act and sentenced to pay fine of **Rs.100/-(Rupees One Hundred only)** and in default of payment of fine to suffer simple imprisonment for five days.

iv) The sentences to run consecutively.

v) Seized property be returned to its owner.

vi) Proceeding closed. Case papers be filed.
