Petition dated 17.10.2025 filed by the petitioner/appellant/accused under S.430(1) of BNSS, praying to extend the time to deposit the 20% of the cheque amount before the trial court.

This petition coming on this day for hearing before this court in the presence of Thiru.S.Devarajan, Advocate for the petitioner and upon hearing the arguments on the side of the petitioner, this court made the following

ORDER

Heard the learned petitioner's counsel.

Claiming an order to extend the period to deposit the 20% of the cheque amount for next one month before the trial court as ordered by the Principal District and Sessions Court, Erode in MP No.1/2025 dated 19.08.2025, the petitioner/appellant/accused has filed this application under S. 430(1) BNSS.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner/appellant/accused has submitted that the execution of sentence of imprisonment imposed upon the petitioner/appellant/accused by the trial court has been already suspended by the Principal District and Sessions court till the disposal of the main appeal, in MP No.1/2025, dated 19.08.2025, with a condition that the petitioner/appellant/accused should deposit 20% of the cheque amount before the trial court within a period of 60 days from the date order, that due viral fever, the petitioner/appellant/accused is unable to deposit the 20% of the cheque amount before the trial court in time as ordered by the court and that therefore, the time to deposit the 20% of the cheque amount before the trial court, may be extended.

Considering the representation of the learned counsel for the petitioner/appellant/accused, this court is inclined to extend 60 days time to deposit the 20% of the cheque amount before the trial court.

In the result, this petition is allowed and the time granted in MP No.1/2025, dated 19.08.2025, to deposit the 20% of the cheque amount before the trial court is hereby extended 60 days with the same conditions.
