This petition coming on this day for hearing before me in the presence of M/s. B.Karthik, S.R.Vivekanandan and G.Prasanna for the petitioners/Accused and of Learned APP, upon hearing and perusing the records, this court passes the following.

ORDER

Petition for bail.

Alleged offence u/s 380, 451 IPC, theft of iron and job materials form a locked concern.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the occurrence was in the last week of may 2021, but he complaint was lodged on 07.06.2021 and that as there is delay in filing the First Information Report, the petitioner may be released on bail. He would also submit that the property has been recovered.

He also stats that theft could not happen as securities were working round the clock. However, 2 co-accused are still at large, investigation is thus far from over. Letting out the petitioner an bail would compromise the investigation.

Records show that there is no unexplained delay in filing complaint as it was done the same day when the theft in the locked premises had case to the knowledge of the defacto/complainant.

Bail petition is dismissed.
