This condition Relaxation petition has been filed and came up for final hearing before this court in presence of **Mr.A.Antony Robinston** learned Advocate for petitioners, and **Mrs.N.Anitha**, learned Assistant Public Prosecutor for respondent and upon perusing the petition, records and objections and upon hearing both sides, this court delivered the following:

**ORDER**

Petition filed for condition Relaxation, praying to relax the condition imposed in C.M.P.No.361/2026

1. The petitioners in Crime Number. 51/2026 of Erode Taluk police Station, Erode had submitted this condition relaxation application seeking for condition relaxation stating that the petitioners got bail in C.M.P.No.361/2026 dated 18.02.2026 with the condition that the petitioners shall appear and sign before the respondent

police station daily at 10.00 am for a period of one month. The Petitioners are obeying the condition from 21.02.2026 to 03.03.2026 for 11 days. The Petitioners are the only bread winners of their family. The Petitioners are innocent and they are falsely implicated in this case. Hence, the petitioners prays to fully relax the condition.

2. The learned Assistant Public Prosecutor who was forwarded with the condition relaxation application, has replied that the petitioners have been charged for offence u/s. 296(b), 115(2), 118(1), 351(3) BNS in Crime Number. 51/2026 of Erode Taluk police Station. The petitioners are complying condition regularly from 21.02.2026 to till date at morning 10.00 a.m without fail. The 2<sup>nd</sup> accused originally belongs to Salem District. If the condition is relaxed, he may abscond and he may also avoid the case and the investigation proceedings. The Petitioners may also threaten the witnesses of this case. Hence, the Prosecution strongly opposed to relax the condition.

3. Heard both sides. Records perused. Petition and objection are taken into consideration. The petitioners have been arrested and remanded to judicial custody on 16.02.2026 for offence u/s. 296(b), 115(2), 118(1), 351(3) BNS and the Petitioners got bail in C.M.P.No.361/2026 dated 18.02.2026 and the petitioners are complying condition regularly from 21.02.2026 to 10.03.2026 at 10.00 a.m for the past 18 days. Due to this condition, the petitioners were unable to attend their day today work. Considering the fact that the petitioners are complying with the conditions regularly, the condition imposed to the petitioners are totally relaxed and the Petitioners shall

not abscond or tamper witnesses/evidences and should appear before the concerned police whenever required and also should appear before this court when summoned.

Accordingly, In the interest of Justice, the condition is totally relaxed as above and the petition stands allowed.
