This case was coming before me for final hearing on this date 10.03.2026 and the Learned Assistant Public Prosecutor appeared for the respondent and the Learned Counsel Mrs.S.Nathiya appeared in person for the Petitioner after perusing the arguments advanced by both sides this court passed the following.

**ORDER**

The Petitioner / accused is involved in Crime No.60/2026 on the file of the respondent police registered for offence U/s. 115(2), 118(1), 296(b), 351(3) of BNS and he seeks bail.

2. The Petitioner had filed the petition u/s.480 of BNSS for the offence U/s. 115(2), 118(1), 296(b), 351(3) of BNS. The Petitioner submits that he is innocent and not guilty. He was arrested and remanded to judicial custody on 24.02.2026. The offence is a non bailable one. He submits that he is ready to furnish sureties and is also willing to abide any condition imposed by this Court. Thus, he prays that he may be granted bail.

3. Heard, records perused. Reply received from the Learned Assistant Public Prosecutor and the concerned police. The prosecution strongly objects that, the investigation is pending and the accused is involved in offence of U/s. 115(2), 118(1), 296(b), 351(3) of BNS. If he is enlarged on bail, he may abscond and tamper the witness, it will be very difficult to trace him out and he will not appear before this Honourable Court and he will commit the same kind of offence again.

4. This Court considered the submissions and perused the materials available on the record. The accused has been remanded on 24.02.2026. Considering the fact that the accused was in custody for past 15 days. On considering the above facts and the period incarceration this Court is inclined to grant bail to the Petitioners/accused with the below conditions.

(i). That the Petitioner shall execute a bond for Rs.10,000/- along with two sureties for like the sum and satisfaction of this Court.

(ii). The Petitioner shall appear before the investigation officer as and when required and also co-operate with investigation.

(iii). The Petitioner shall not tamper the evidence or witness either during investigation or trial.

(iv). The Petitioner shall appear before the Respondent Police Station daily at 10.00 AM and sign for 15 days.

(v). The Petitioners shall not abscond either during investigation or trial.

5. In the result the Bail petition filed in CrI MP 502 of 2026 on the file of this Court is allowed.
