This petition coming before me for final hearing on this day 10.03.2026 in the presence of Mrs.S.Nathiya, B.A., M.L.,PGADR., Advocate for the petitioner/Accused and the Learned Assistant Public Prosecutor Grade II appearing for the respondent and on hearing the arguments of both sides, this Court delivers the following:

ORDER

The accused stands charged U/s. 296(b), 118(2), 351(3) of BNS and he remanded in Judicial custody from 03.03.2026. The accused has filed this application contending that he is not guilty and he did not commit the said offence and he is a innocent person. The prosecution opposed the application contending that if the accused is released on bail he may abscond and tamper the evidence and witnesses and this accused belongs to other state and investigation yet to be completed.

Heard. Considering the nature of offence, period of remand and on perusing the records, the accused in Judicial custody for the past 8 days. Victim also discharged from hospital. Hence the accused is entitled to get bail. Therefore this

court is inclined to release the accused on bail and he executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- with two sureties like sum each. The accused shall appear and sign before the respondent police station daily at 10.00 A.M until further orders.
