This petition coming before me for final hearing on this day 03.06.2026 in the presence of Mr.T.Vimal.,B.A.,B.L., Advocate for the Petitioner / Accused and the Learned Assistant Public Prosecutor Grade II appearing for the respondent and on hearing the arguments of both sides, this Court delivers the following:

ORDER

The accused stands charged U/s. 3(a) of RP (UP) Act and he remanded in Judicial custody from 08.05.2026. The accused has filed this application contending that he is not guilty and he did not commit the said offence. The prosecution opposed the application contending that if the accused is released on bail he may abscond and tamper the evidence and witnesses and also he may involve the same kind of offences.

Heard. Considering the nature of offence, period of remand and on perusing the records, the accused in Judicial custody the past 27 days. Property also recovered. Hence the accused is entitled to get bail. Therefore this court is inclined to release the accused on bail and he executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- with two sureties like sum each. The accused shall appear and sign before Respondent police station daily at 10.00 A.M until further orders.
