This case was coming before me for final hearing on this date 08.06.2026 and the Learned Assistant Public Prosecutor appeared for the respondent and the Learned Counsel Mrs.S.Nathiya appeared for the Petitioner after perusing the arguments advanced by both sides this court passed the following.

ORDER

The Petitioner / accused is involved in Crime No.186/2026 on the file of the respondent police registered for offence U/s. 331(4), 305(a) of BNS and he seeks bail.

2. The Petitioner had filed the petition U/s.480 of BNSS for the offence U/s. 331(4), 305(a) of BNS. The Petitioner submits that he is innocent and not guilty. He was arrested and remanded to judicial custody on 06.05.2026. The offence is a non bailable one. He submits that he is ready to furnish sureties and is also willing to abide any condition imposed by this Court. Thus, he prays that he may be granted bail.

3. Heard, records perused. Reply received from the concerned police and the Learned Assistant Public Prosecutor. The prosecution strongly objects that, the investigation is pending and the accused is involved in offence of U/s. 331(4), 305(a) of BNS. If he is enlarged on bail, he may abscond and tamper the witness, it will be very difficult to trace him out and he will not appear before this Honourable Court and he will commit the same kind of offence again.

4. On further perusal of the First Information Report it is alleged that, the Petitioner/accused have involved in the offense of house breaking and theft of the gold jewels of 11 sovereign which belongs to the defacto complainant Tmt.Kalaiselvi. And on further perusal of the reply, it seems that there are three case already filed against the petitioner/accused in Chithode PS in Cr.No.54/2024, Cr.No.196/2023, Cr.No.300/2021 and there is a case already filed against the petitioner/accused in Vellode PS in Cr.No.228/2022 and further stated that the investigation is still pending for this case. On perusal of the case bundles, it seems that a bail was already filed by the petitioner/accused in CrIMP No.1006/2026 and it was dismissed on 27.05.2026. This is the second bail petition filed by the petitioner/accused. No circumstances changed. So in this stage, this Court feels that if the Petitioner/accused is enlarged on bail, he may do the same and also there is a chance to tampering the witnesses. On considering the gravity of the offence and the fact & circumstances of the case, this Court not inclined to grant this bail.

5. In the result the Bail petition in CrIMP No.1083/2026 on the file of this Court is here by dismissed.
