A3 to A8 present. A1 hospitalised and appeared through V.C. A2 surrendered. A1 and A2 filed warrant recall petition and the same was allowed. Advocate Mr.A.Vijay filed vakalath alongwith surrender, Bailable warrant recall and admission petition. All petition are allowed. On considering the voluntary admission this Court found accused guilty for the offence u/s12 of TNG Act with a fine of Rs.5000/- for each, in default 1 week simple imprisonment for each. Total fine Rs.40,000/- P.R. 127/2025 Playing card to be destroyed. Amount to be confiscated.
